- 1. Print or type scholarship application. If necessary, use additional sheet(s) of paper. You must include your full name on each additional sheet.
- 2. Freshmen applicants who do not have college credits must include a high school transcript with their application.
- 3. Financial need is determined through the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Students applying for scholarships with a financial need consideration should submit the FAFSA by March 15 (www.fafsa.ed.gov).
- 4. Only those students admitted to VHCC will be considered for scholarships.
- 5. Scholarship Information:
 - a. Scholarships are awarded for fall and spring semesters and are not available for the summer semester.
 - b. Scholarship awards are based on the availability of funds and the criteria set forth by the appropriate governing body and are subject to change.
