

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

PROGRAMS OF STUDY FOR COMPUTER SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY, AND INFORMATION SCIENCE AND SYSTEMS (including concentrations in Computer Science, Software Engineering, Database, Networks, Information Systems, Enterprise Systems Development, and Web Development)

RADFORD UNIVERSITY & Virginia Highlands Community College

WHEREAS, **Virginia Highlands Community College** and Radford University exist to provide educational services and opportunities; and

WHEREAS, **Virginia Highlands Community College** and Radford University cooperate effectively to ensure that citizens of the Commonwealth receive the highest quality educational experiences and opportunities; and

WHEREAS, **Virginia Highlands Community College** and Radford University desire to reduce transfer barriers between the two institutions; now and

THEREFORE, **Virginia Highlands Community College** and Radford University make the following articulation agreement:

GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. Admission to the Radford University (RU) Bachelor of Science programs in Computer Science and Technology, and Information Science and Systems, will be open to any **Virginia Highlands Community College (VHCC)** student who has successfully completed, from the date of this agreement forward, the Software Development Fast Track Program.
2. Only courses completed at an accredited institution with a grade of "C" or higher will be considered for transfer into this program.
3. The program requirements may be modified to conform to any changes in Radford University or the degree requirements of the respective programs. Any such revisions will be communicated to currently enrolled students and the Academic Dean of Virginia Highlands Community College by November 15th preceding the academic year in which the new requirement would take effect. Radford University reserves the right to change, when warranted, any of the provisions of this agreement, course offerings, assigned teaching faculty, calendars, class locations, and fees as might be required.
