Article 1: Name of Club

Article 2: Purpose

Along with a chance to go out and enjoy the marvelous game of disc golf. We hope to reach the student body and offer a fun sport that will raise student spirits and activity levels. The purpose of our club hopes to reach further than just the student body however. We have aspirations of bringing the whole disc golf community of Southwest Virginia together. When all is said and done our purpose is disc golf. We are very passionate about this game and look forward to bringing the wonderful game to many people lives.

Article 3: Membership

Membership will be open to any and all students of Virginia Highlands Community College. Membership will also be open to all VHCC Alumni's. If a club member violates the VHCC student conduct code they may be subject to a membership suspension.

Article 4: Meetings

Section 1: Meetings

We will be holding our meetings on the 2nd and the 4th Thursday of every month; at 2 PM. Further meetings will be announced and posted on the VHCC Website, Blackboard site, and Hall Monitors.

Section 2: Quorum/Majority Defined for most clubs/organizations, decisions are brought to the membership for a vote.

Before a vote can be taken, a quorum must be met. A quorum is defined as the minimum number of members who have to be at the meeting for the group's business to be conducted. Quorum shall be defined as the majority of the Club Officers.

Article 5: Dues

There will be no dues in order to join the club.

Article 6: Officers and Officer Elections

Section 1: Officers

- Owner (Advisor): Oversees/approves all club activities and functions. Owner has final say in all executive decisions.
- General Manger (President): In charge of off course responsibilities such as; public affairs, planning events, and off course club gatherings.
- Head Coach (Vice President): In charge of on course responsibilities such as planning tournaments, preparing tournaments, and planning other on course activities.
- Assistant Coach (Secretary): Responsible for the safe keeping of course records and aid other officers on and off course decision making.

Section 2: Election

Elections will be held once per calendar year at the first meeting of the fall semester. If an officer resigns, graduates, or loses office for any undisclosed reason then another election will be held at such time as is need. If an election is seen unfit by the club advisor he/she will have the power of hand to appoint club officer(s).

Section 3: Officer Removal Process

If an officer's actions or motives are deemed unfit and or harmful to the club, he or she may be removed from office. In order for an officer to be removed from office, all other officers must agree unanimously. If an officer is indeed removed from office, the club advisor will be responsible for readjusting the cabinet.

Article 7: Committees

This section is not applicable to the VHCC Trees Disc Golf Club. As of right now we do not have any internal committees; nor have any plans of having any at the moment.

Article 8: Tournaments

We will be looking to host at least two tournaments per semester. The primary day the tournaments will be held is on Saturday. The first tournament per semester will be a singles tournament. These tournaments will be where each individual player plays for himself and by himself. The second tournament will be a doubles tournament. A tournament in doubles format means there will be two players on each team. These tournaments will have an entry fee; as well as prize(s) for the top competitors of the tournaments. Each tournament will consist of 18 holes. Whether it be by playing our course twice, or using a custom set up made and established by the VHCC Trees Disc Golf Club.
