Tutoring & Practice

- For tutoring help, connect with the MARC (Moose Academic Resource Center) at https://www.vhcc.edu/tutoring-center. The MARC offers tutoring in math, biology, English, ITE and other subjects. Both in-person and online tutoring are available. TEAS tutoring is also available through the MARC in the Library in the Learning Resource Center. MARC staff can help determine where review may be helpful in math, science, English, and reading comprehension. If you are retaking the TEAS and request tutoring in specific subjects, print a complete copy of your TEAS transcript that shows the Topics to Review and bring that with you to the MARC. TEAS transcripts may be accessed at any time in the student's ATI account at http://www.atitesting.com under the main menu, click on My Results, click on the exam attempt and then select Download Report.
