I. POLICY

It is the policy of Virginia Highlands Community College (VHCC) to publish guidelines for readmitting students to a special admission curriculum if the student has not been enrolled in that curriculum for a period of at least one year (three consecutive academic terms).

II. PERTINENT INFORMATION

- A. VHCC Special Admission programs include the following:
1. Associate of Applied Science in Emergency Medical Services Technology-Paramedic
 2. Associate of Applied Science in Nursing
 3. Associate of Applied Science in Radiography
 4. Career Studies Certificate in Medical Assisting
 5. Certificate in Practical Nursing

III. DEFINITIONS

- A. Special Admissions: an application process where specific criteria must be met before being admitted into a specific program of study.

IV. GENERAL GUIDELINES

- A. Exceptions to this policy may be made by the College President or designee only for documented reasons.

V. DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

- A. The College President has the authority and delegates to the Vice President of Instruction and Student Services the responsibility to establish procedures to meet the requirements of this policy.

- A. Each spring, special admissions programs listed above will assess the readmission policy and make any updates prior to March 1.

- C. A copy of the program handbooks, including the readmissions policies, must be kept in the Office of Admissions and Records.
